Major Duties

Performs a variety of skilled manual tasks and operates all types of equipment in highway maintenance activities. More experienced workers may be assigned to a crew as the working leader training lesser skilled workers under the direction of a foreman or assistant foreman or may be assigned to a specialized task which is performed independently.

Typical Examples of Work

- 1. Operates all types of general maintenance equipment such as: trucks, rollers, front end loaders, tractors, motor graders, snow plows, dragline, backhoe, and distributors.
- 2. May also operate specialized equipment or perform special tasks such as: laydown machine, rock cutter, snooper, pavement stripper, gas transport, semi-truck trailer, chip spreader and/or similar equivalent type equipment.
- 3. Performs preventative maintenance on assigned equipment and assists in the servicing and repair.
- 4. Performs manual labor such as patching, sign repair, erecting and taking down snow fence, bridge and culvert repair, loading and unloading materials.
- 5. Performs related work as required.
- 6. Operate two way radio.

Qualifications for the Job

Education or experience sufficient to enable the individual to perform the duties and meet the knowledge, skills, and abilities required. Must meet agency qualification standards to be eligible for this class position. Must possess a valid Nebraska driver's license and have the ability to obtain a CDL (commercial driver's license). Those required to have a CDL will be in a safety sensitive work position at all times. Ability to fill out job reports and worksheets.

Knowledge Skills and Abilities Required on the Job

- 1. Knowledge of use, operation, maintenance and minor repair of all maintenance equipment employed.
- 2. Knowledge of the methods and materials used in the type of construction on which the equipment is operated or the work is performed.
- 3. Knowledge of safety practices and methods to expedite and perform work efficiently under quantity production schedules.
- 4. Ability to carry out written or oral instructions without constant personal supervision.
- 5. Ability to supervise subordinates.
- 6. Ability to do heavy manual work in hazardous locations under varying climatic conditions.
- 7. Perform other duties as assigned.

Working Conditions

Occasional extended standing, walking, heavy lifting (50 pounds or more), cramped positions, elements, seasonal temperature variations. Constant exposure to noise, heat and grease. Exposure to both stationary and mobile equipment with moving parts. Prolonged standing or walking.
