Greeley County Commissioner Minutes

An Emergency Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Greeley County, Nebraska was held at 11:30 a.m. on Monday, March 18, 2019 in the Commissioners Room. Vice Chairman Jordan Foltz called the meeting to order and the Commissioners present for roll call were Jordan Foltz and Joe Leslie. Michael Goldfish-excused absence. Also present was County Attorney Cindy Bassett, Clerk Mindy Grossart & Mark Bauer, Emergency Manager. Randy Dutcher Activities/Transportation Director for Central Valley Public Schools was present for part of the meeting.

Vice Chairman Foltz noted the Open Meeting Laws are posted and available to the public. County Attorney Cindy Bassett asked the Board Vice Chairman to call for an emergency meeting as the next regular scheduled Board meeting is March 26, 2019. The emergency meeting is to review and outline safe routes for travel on Greeley County rural roads.

The Board members worked with Emergency Manager, Mark Bauer to outline emergency routes for Emergency Personnel. They marked bridge out, impassable roads and 4-wheel drive vehicles only. They will update the maps as repairs can be made. Road District #1 was still assessing the damages and plan to outline that portion of the map on March 19th with Mark Bauer, Emergency Manager.

The Board members recommended putting a notice in the paper about the hazardous road conditions. They also recommended suspending the rural bus routes until further notice.

Motion made by Leslie to adjourn the emergency meeting at 12:40 p.m., second by Foltz.
