

Greeley County Commissioner Minutes
March 10, 2026

The Greeley County Board of Commissioners convened in open and public session at 9:30 a.m. on the 10th day of March 2026 in the Boardroom, Greeley County Courthouse. Notice of the meeting was given by publication in the Cedar Valley News.

Answering present at Roll Call were Joe Leslie, and Dennis Wadsworth. Chairman Jordan Foltz was absent – excused. County Attorney Joe McNally and County Clerk Mindy Grossart were also present. Vice Chairman Leslie noted that the open public meetings act information is posted as required by law and available for public distribution if requested.
