

Greeley County Commissioner Minutes
June 9, 2026

The Greeley County Board of Commissioners convened in open and public session at 9:30 a.m. on the 9th day of June 2026 in the Boardroom, Greeley County Courthouse. Notice of the meeting was given by publication in the Cedar Valley News.

Answering present at Roll Call were Jordan Foltz, Joe Leslie, and Dennis Wadsworth. Also, present were County Attorney, Joe McNally and County Clerk Mindy Grossart. Chairman Foltz stated a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the east wall of the County Boardroom and copies were available for the public if requested. Happy Jack Chalk Mine Association applied for a Special Designated License (SDL) for Puttin off the Peak that will take place on July 18th & 19th from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., event to be held at 80131 Hwy 11 Scotia, NE 68875. Motion made by Wadsworth to approve the issuance of a SDL as requested by Happy Jack Chalk Mine Association, seconded by Leslie. Roll Call Vote: All yes, motion carried.

Sheriff's Department updates: Deputy Jay Welch was present and stated there are working on some computer system issues and radio repeater troubleshooting. He wanted to thank Tom Langer, Greeley County Roads District #3 for his quick response and assistance with a recent accident near Spalding. Sheriff Deaver submitted a monthly activity report including 82 calls for service: 29 traffic contacts, 5 accidents, 6 fire/rescue assists and 5 reckless drivers. The office also issued 5 gun permits, and 5 vehicle inspections.

County Attorney Joe McNally requested an Executive Session to discuss Potential Litigation. Leslie moved to enter Executive Session at 9:48 a.m., seconded by Wadsworth. Roll Call Vote: All yes, motion carried. The County Board, County Attorney and Andrew Willis, Cline Williams were present for the executive session. Motion made by Wadsworth to return to regular session at 11:03 a.m., seconded by Leslie. Roll Call Vote: All yes, motion carried.

Motion by Leslie to adjourn at 11:04 a.m., second by Wadsworth. Roll Call Vote: All yes, motion carried. The next regular meeting is scheduled for June 23, 2026.
